ECLIPSE IN TARRAGONA: A Total Experience

On 12 August, at 20:29, the Moon will completely cover the Sun and cast a shadow over the Earth, turning day into night for 61 seconds.

Choosing the right spot to observe the eclipse is very important. You need to find a location with a clear view of the western horizon, so you can see the sunset. Choose open, spacious areas such as squares, natural settings or elevated spots with good visibility. Whenever possible, it is recommended to avoid travelling.

The Town Council recommends these viewing sites for observing the eclipse with adequate visibility and safety, in case you cannot see it from home:

- **Bonavista** (up to 15,000 people)
- **Anella Mediterrània** (up to 10,000 people)
- **Parc del Francolí** (up to 2,000 people)
- **Sescelades Campus Car Parking** (up to 7,000 people)

All these viewing sites are free and open to the public.

The Town Hall has also made the following viewing sites available:

- **Marina Port Tarraco** (up to 20,000 people). Throughout the afternoon and into the early hours, there will be cultural and gastronomic activities for everyone to enjoy this exceptional phenomenon together. In collaboration with the Port of Tarragona.

- **Football pitch of Sant Pere i Sant Pau** (up to 1,500 people)

In both cases, access is free of charge, but advance online booking will be required.

An eclipse is an extraordinary phenomenon. To enjoy it safely, it is essential to follow these recommendations:

- **Never look at the Sun without adequate protection.** The glasses must be special eclipse glasses, certified to ISO 12312-2. Conventional sunglasses are not suitable for this purpose.
- **Avoid using homemade methods.** Tinted glasses, X-rays or other improvised systems are not safe.
- **Children must always be supervised by an adult when observing the eclipse.**
