7pm,	Plaça de la Font Square. The arrival of the water from La Brufaganya
7.15pm,	from Plaça de la Font Square. The ascent towards the Portal del Carro. Carts carrying the <i>Sant Magí</i> water head towards the <i>Sant Magí</i> Chapel (on Portal del Carro) accompanied by the “Seguici de Sant Magí” (<i>Sant Magí</i> entourage), made up of different folkloric features such as the Gi-ants and the Big Heads and traditional dances. Itinerary: Cós del Bou, Baixada Pescateria, Nau, Major, Santiago Rusiñol Sqr., Merceria, Pare Iglésias, Les Coques and Arc de Sant Llorenç / Portal del Carro.

Itinerary: Baixada Misericòrdia, Major, Santiago Rusiñol, Merceria, Pare Iglesias, les Coques, Sant Pau and Pla de Palau.

9pm,	approximately, Plaça de la Font Square. “Tanda de lluïment del Seguici de Sant Magí” (<i>Sant Magí</i> entourage in full performance): Different tra-ditional dances, giants, etc.
9pm,	Rambla Nova, in front of the sardana monument, Sardanes dancing with the Coblà Reus Jove.
Midnight,	Pub Highland, 9 Rambla Vella. Play Time Highland.
