From 16 to 19 August

This Sant Magí festivity programme aims at drawing city visitors and tourists closer to this great event. The programme includes detailed information about the festivity; however not all Sant Magí events are listed below, only the most representative ones.

PRELIMINARY EVENTS

Tuesday, 10 August

20:00, Church of Sant Llorenç. **Mass of Sant Llorenç**. Followed by a blessing and the distribution of basil among attendees. Limited capacity in accordance with current measures.

12:00, from an unspecified point in the city. *Tronada*: Opening mortar volley and tribute. Fireworks are part of our most festive tradition, and a mortar volley will mark the official opening of the Festival of Sant Magí 2021. This mortar volley will be preceded by twenty-one pyrotechnic salvos to honor the memory of the victims of Covid-19 and to thank all the professional and social groups that have worked, and continue to work, to minimize its impact. The firework company Pirotècnia Garcia, from Lliçà d'Amunt (Barcelona), will fire the salvos and the mortar volley.

21:30, Camp de Mart Auditorium Theatre. Sopa de Cabra in concert, as part of their thirtieth anniversary tour, Ben Endins: the portrait of a generation.

Tuesday, 17 August

At first light, from Sant Magí de la Brufaganya in Portils, the bearers of Tarragona's most sacred water will make the traditional **water march** with their carts and horses, passing through Santa Perpètua de Gaià, Querol, El Pont d'Armentera, Santes Creus, Vila-rodona and Bràfim, where they will spend the night.

Wednesday, 18 August

At dawn, from Brafim, the **second stage of the water march** that started the day before from La Brufaganya begins, today passing through Nulles, L'Argilaga, El Catllar and Els Pallaresos, finally reaching Tarragona.

Around 12:00 noon, after a long journey, **the water of Sant Magí will reach Tarragona**, to be distributed across the whole city. Our thanks go to its bearers!

17:00, **opening of the Sant Magí water distribution points**, with jugs, ribbons and fresh basil. Eight different stands have been set up across the city, with the support of the *Casteller* groups and the Neighbourhood Associations of Bonavista, Virgen del Pilar and Eixample, the Progressive Neighbourhood Association of Torreforta, and the Campclar - Zona Esportiva Neighbourhood Association. Thursday, 19 August. Day of Sant Magi

05:00, Church of El Portal del Carro, **First Mass.** Other religious ceremonies will be held every hour until 21:00. All Masses are organized by the administrators of the Saint's chapel.

07:00. **The traditional morning serenades of Sant Magí,** by groups of local *gralla* players, who walk the main streets and squares of the city to the sounds and rhythms of the *grallas* (double reed instruments) and kettledrums.

10:00, Portal del Carro. **Opening of the Portal del Carro** to facilitate people's time-honoured access to the epicentre of the festivities. It will be open continuously through to 20:00. Access is via Carrer de l'Arc de Sant Llorenç only. Exit is via Carrer de l'Escorxador only. Limited capacity. Please follow the directions of the organization.

10:00, **opening of the Sant Magí water distribution stands**, with jugs, ribbons and fresh basil. Eight different stands have been set up across the city, with the support of the *Casteller* groups and the Neighbourhood Associations of Bonavista, Virgen del Pilar and Eixample, the Progressive Neighbourhood Association of Torreforta, and the Campclar - Zona Esportiva Neighbourhood Association. This mortar volley and the twenty-one salvos that precede it accompany the formal salute columns raised by the city's human tower-builders and the last few metres travelled by the image of Sant Magí to the chapel at El Portal del Carro. The Pirotècnia Catalana firework company from Vimbodí will fire the salvos and the mortar volley.

COVID-19 PROTOCOL

The areas where the Sant Magí festival takes place will adhere to the following protocols at all times in accordance with current regulations:

- Daily disinfection of every venue.
- At the entrance to all venues there will be hand sanitiser dispensers.
- Seating capacities and layout must meet the required safety distances.
- Access to and exits from venues will be done in a staggered way under the control of the on-site staff to
 ensure the safety distance is adhered to.
- No festival leaflets or programmes will be provided at any of the venues. Information will only be available online.
- Different entrances and exits will be set up wherever necessary to avoid overcrowding.

INDIVIDUAL RECOMMENDATIONS

- Remember that you should maintain a safe distance between people at every venue.
- The use of face masks is mandatory in enclosed spaces and in public spaces with insufficient safety distance.
- Access to and exits from venues will be done in stages. Always follow the signs and directions of the onsite staff.
- You should arrive at performance venues at least 30 minutes in advance to allow for this staggered
 access. Otherwise, we cannot guarantee the seat selected at the time of purchase (see the detailed
 information for each venue below).
- We recommend that you download the ticket to your smartphone to minimize contact with paper.
- If you think you may have symptoms of Covid-19 or have been in contact with someone diagnosed with the virus, please stay at home. We're bound to have the chance to meet again in public venues soon!
- If you drink alcohol, please do so responsibly and in moderation.
- If you have to drive, please do not drink alcohol as it seriously impairs your driving ability.
